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Diagram 1: 2017 Global Diabetes Growth Profile


Diagram 2: Methods of Monitoring



Functions of Independent Monitoring Committee

Hong Kong Diabetes Health Association (HKDHA) invites professionals and celebrities from various sectors all over the world to be voluntary Monitoring Officers of Independent Monitoring Committee participating in the "Glycated Hemoglobin (HbA1c) Clinical Trial Study Project". This independently operated committee plays an active external monitoring effect to enhance the credibility of the clinical evidence to be published upon completion of the Research Project.

The Monitoring Officers have full authority to exercise their power of supervision without the interference from the administration of HKDHA, individuals or social organizations. Its function is to ensure the reliability and trustworthiness of the operation of the "Glycated Hemoglobin (HbA1c) Clinical Trial Study Project"; such as project arrangement, resources, data collection, preparation of nature herbal tea and patient management which include:

a. Patient Management

- a1. Set up recruitment process for Type II diabetes patients
- a2. Schedule 20 day therapy arrangement and implementation
- a3. Assess patient health status
- a4. Patients receive the same standard of treatment
- a5. Monitor medical staff performance and follow up treatment progress
- a6. Employ critical contingency measures

b. Clinical Trial Study Site Quality and Supporting Facilities

- b1. Assure on-site medical quality
- b2. Examine on-site medical supporting facilities
- b3. Ascertain on-site hygienic standards

c. Natural Herbal Tea and Chenpi Tea Quality Control

- c1. Monitor herbal tea preparation process.
- c2. Evaluate Natural Herbal Tea and Chengpi Tea quality by random spot checks.

d. Dietary Quality Assurance

- d1. Ascertain dietary preparation process.
- d2. Evaluate meal quality by random spot checks.

- e. Information and Data Collection Process
 - e1. Patient data collection and security management.
 - e2. Data collection from all categories and accuracy assurance.
- f. Work arrangements and quality of implementation in each category
- 4. Duties of Independent Monitoring Committee Members

Tn order to meet the monitoring requirements of the above-mentioned functions, the independent monitoring committee will supervise the work in different fields randomly and in the form of "Diagram 2" below.

Monitoring



The Monitoring Officers are to be provided with identification vests as soon as they are on site. Every officer is indiscriminately assigned to different fields to perform surveillance by using following methods:

A. [Interview]

Monitoring Officers randomly visit patients, management personnel and frontline staff to understand the detailed arrangements and implementation status of the work in different fields. The findings are to be recorded down on the provided checklist and verified with authorized signatures.

B. [Inquiry]

Through inquiry about the job arrangement and its effect on the research project is to be carried out to fully understand its practicability and effectiveness about the research project. The findings are to be recorded down on the provided checklist and verified with authorized signatures.

C. [Observation]

Monitoring Officers conduct independent observations in various fields of work, and understand the detailed arrangements and implementation status of work in different fields during the observation process, and select the work that has been observed or write down after observing the matter in the relevant inspection list and verified with authorized signatures.

D. [Sampling]

Monitoring Officers shall make random sampling requirements in all areas of work. Relevant inspection items shall be submitted to an accredited inspection agency for professional analysis. The returned inspection reports shall be submitted to the staff of Hong Kong Diabetes Health Association for records.

E. [Review]

Monitoring Officers may randomly make relevant work review requests to personnel in different fields of work. After completing the review, fill in the relevant inspection list of the monitoring committee and verified with authorized signatures.
